Banana Cake

1 Yellow Cake Mix 5-6 Ripe Bananas

Mix cake according to package directions and bake in three 9" cake pans or two 9" inch cake pans depending on preference (I use 2).

Frosting

8 oz. Sour Cream (I use 6 oz. because the frosting is a little sour)

1 cup Granulated Sugar

8 oz. Whipped Topping (Cool Whip)

Stir together sour cream and sugar first. When mixed well add the Cool Whip. The sugar will not dissolve if added to the Cool Whip first.

Slice bananas crossways ¼" thick and cover the first layer. It takes about 2 bananas per layer. Spread frosting over the bananas. Repeat with remaining layer/layers then frost the sides with remaining frosting. Store cake in the refrigerator.
