

Banana Cake

1 Yellow Cake Mix

Mix cake according to package directions and bake in three 9" cake pans

5-6 Ripe Bananas (layer between cake layer and frosting)

Frosting

8 oz. Sour Cream

1 cup Granulated Sugar

8 oz. Whipped Topping (1/2 of a large Cool Whip container, a little extra is always better too)

Stir together sour cream and sugar first. When mixed well add the Cool Whip. The sugar will not dissolve if added to the Cool Whip first.

Slice bananas crossways $\frac{1}{4}$ " thick and cover the first layer. It takes about 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ - 2 bananas per layer. Spread frosting over the bananas. Repeat with remaining layers then frost the sides with remaining frosting. Store cake in the refrigerator.
